2021-22 Student Registration!

Student Registration information for next school year.

OLLRCS has been blessed with amazing students/families this year! We have 3 of our 4 classrooms completely filled and a waiting list in 2 of our 4 classrooms. Our school office has already received inquiries for the upcoming school year and indicators show we will be at our full capacity in some sections. Classrooms will be capped at 15 students in grades 1st - 8th and 18 students in PreK/K for next year, assuring class sizes maintain a small teacher-student ratio. We encourage you to register your child through our FACTS family portal and pay the \$100 registration fee plus the \$10 FACTS fee as soon as you are eligible to do so if you intend on returning. As you can see below, we are giving our existing families first priority to re-enroll for

the next school year. There is a \$50 refund for registering before the end of this school year.

- Open registration for returning families begins April 19th
- Open registration for parish families begins May 3rd
- Open registration for all families begins May 10

Once a section is filled, students will be placed on a waiting list. Additional sections will open when/if OLLRCS hires a highly qualified teacher that possesses the loving, caring, hard-working, and extremely dedicated qualities that our existing teachers have. OLLRCS is committed to providing a high-quality academic and spiritual education with small class sizes encompassed in a safe environment. We can not save spots for returning families past May 2nd as enrolment opens up for parish families and the general public on May 10th.

We would like to thank Mrs. Patti Gruber for her ministry at the OLL Parish and School. Her dedication has been extremely beneficial to Our Lady of the Lake. We wish her the very best as she begins the next chapter of her life.
