2021-22 Student Registration!

Student Registration information for next school year.

We have had several inquiries about enrolment for the 2021-2022 school year. Enrolment information will be announced to the general public after Spring break. Classrooms will be capped to 15 students in grades 1st - 8th and 18 students in PreK/K for next year, assuring class sizes maintain a small teacher-student ratio. We encourage you to register your child through our FACTS family portal and pay the non-refundable \$100 registration fee plus the \$10 FACTS fee as soon as you are eligible to do so if you intend on returning. As you can see below, we are giving our existing families first priority to re-enroll for the next school year.

- Registration for returning families begins April 19th
- Registration for registered parish parents/guardians from OLL and any of our sister parishes begins May 3rd
- Registration for all families begins May 10

Once a section is filled, students will be placed on a waiting list. Additional sections will open when/if OLLRCS is able to hire a highly qualified teacher that possesses the loving, caring, hardworking, and dedicated qualities that our existing teachers have. OLLRCS is committed to providing a high-quality academic and spiritual education with small class sizes encompassed in a safe environment. We can not save spots for returning families as enrolment opens up for registered parish families on May 3rd and the general public on May 10th.

Online Fruit Fundraiser to help with Service Hours!

Laura McNeill has graciously brought an easy online fundraising opportunity to earn your required 100 hours in service. Your oldest child will bring home fruit fundraising information on Monday, March 8th. You will have until spring break or March 25th to sell the fruit packages. It's all done online and the delivery is done for you. So you can sell online to your relative in Texas and they will receive the box of fruit. For every \$12 the school earns, one service hour will be credited to your family's service hours. After the conclusion of this fundraiser, your family's service hour balance will be applied to your bill if you are short on the required 100 service hours.
