### Mask guidence from CMDHD, MMDHD, DHD#10 & MDHHS

Below is the latest update on mask recommendations from the health department. Attached are two documents:

**MI Safer School Guidance Link** 

**Modified Quarantine CMDHD MMDHD DHD#10 Link** 

To summarize: If you choose to have your child wear a mask full time while in the building and there is an exposure, masked students are way less likely to be required to quarantine for the 14 days by the health department.

NOTE: Our Lady of the Lake Regional Catholic School recommends all staff, volunteers, and students wear masks full time. It is your choice whether or not you/your child wear a mask. If you wish for your child to wear a mask full time, please email your child's teacher. Teachers will be happy to remind and encourage your child to wear it consistantly.

- We need your help practicing with your child when putting on shoes, tying shoes, zipping coats, and putting coats/attire on independently.
- As the weather turns colder, please send your child to school with a coat, hat, and mittens. PLEASE LABEL YOUR CHILD'S NAME ON ALL CLOTHING.
- Please contact the office or send a note with your child for all drop off/pick up information. Please do not email or text teachers - they do not always get a chance to check their phones/emails while teaching multiple grades/subjects.
- Our lunch help is assisting 41 students in each of our two 25 minute lunch periods.
   To help them out, please keep foods that need to be heated in a microwave to a minimum and we ask that you do not send any items to be microwaved at all on Pizza Thursdays.

To have traffic flow better for arrival and dismissal, please enter from the EAST by the Chinese restaurant/Church side and exit out the WEST by the school/Dollar store side of the building. If you would like to stay in your vehicle for dismissal, please arrive around 3:15ish and enter from the East. We will recognize most of you and send your child out to you. If you are a new family, a staff member may come to your window to make sure we are sending the correct child with you.
