

NO Direct-Contact of COVID-19 to report

We have been extremely fortunate to not have any direct contact to report at OLLRCS since Christmas break. The next strand of COVID-19 is extremely contagious. Please quarantine if you know your child has been exposed for the safety of our school family.

In the event that your child has direct contact for 15 minutes or more with someone testing positive to COVID, you will be notified by our office staff. Students wearing masks will not be required to quarentine, while unmasked students will be asked to quarantine for 5 school days to maintain a safe, healthy school environment.

NOTE: Our Lady of the Lake Regional Catholic School recommends all staff, volunteers, and students wear masks full time. It is your choice whether or process you/your child wear a mask.

"I've always wanted this!!! Mrs. Pacella what is it?"




