#### **Summer Homework**

Every student was given a summer packet of OPTIONAL work to do when the kids get "board". We do NOT expect all of it to be completed, but we hope that it will help with the "summer slide" retention. Studies show that students lose, on average, about 20 percent of their school-year gains in reading and 27 percent of their school-year gains in math during summer break. Below are some things you can work on over the summer:

#### **Link to "Summer Slide Statistics and Prevention"**

- Read for 15 minutes each day
- Flash cards of adding & subtracting for grades K-3 and multiplying for grades 3-8.
- Practice tying shoes, zipping coats, and other daily skills that can be done independently, even by our youngest students!
- Correcting mispronounced words with your child. When students do not/can not pronounce words correctly, it is increasingly more difficult to spell words and write.
