2023-2024 School Registration Student Registration information for next school year!

OLLRCS has been blessed with amazing students/families! We currently have 4 of our 6 classrooms filled and anticipate we will fill most of our grade levels next year. Classrooms will be capped at 18 students for the 2023-24 school year to maintain a small teacher-student ratio. We encourage you to register your child through our FACTS family portal and pay the \$100 registration non-refundable fee plus the \$10 FACTS fee as soon as you are eligible to do so if you intend on returning. Your 2022-23 tuition account must be up to date with no delinquencies in order to register for the 2023-24 school year.

- Open registration for parish families begins April 17th
- Open registration for all families begins April 24th

Once a section is filled, students will be placed on a waiting list. An additional section may open if OLLRCS is able to hires a highly qualified teacher that possesses the loving, caring, hard-working, and extremely dedicated qualities that our existing teachers have.
