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#### **Arrival & Dismissal**

We had an excellent 1st week of school with almost everyone following our Arrival and Dismissal procedure. Just a friendly reminder to enter the back of the school from the EAST entrance (by the post office) and drop off their child at the back cafeteria door and exit the school using the WEST exit, by the dollar store. If you are walking your child up to the school, we ask that you park your car away from the building to not disrupt the flow of traffic. - Make sure your child has a refillable water bottle for our new filtered water fountains.
- We need your help in making your child more independent: Practice tying shoes, zipping coats, opening their own packaged food, dressing themselves including coats, snow pants, hats and mittens, and scarfs. Also, please wear shorts or leggings under dresses/skirts.
- PreK-2nd graders: Please remember to return your class folders every day. This is how our teachers communicate with parents daily. Thank you!
- Please contact the office or send a note with your child for all drop off/pick up information. Please do not email or text teachers - they do not always get a chance to check their phones/emails while teaching multiple grades/subjects.
- Our lunch help is assisting 90 students this year in our two 25 minute lunch periods. To help them out, please keep foods that need to be heated in a microwave to a minimum and we ask that your child use a thermos if their item needs to be microwaved more than 30 sec.

School doors open at 7:40am this year. Please do not drop your child off before 7:40am, unless your child is safety patrolling. State licensing prevents us from opening our doors earlier. I am very sorry for the inconvenience.

## **After School Tutoring/Programs**

OLLRCS will begin our after school (STAR Track) tutoring program on September 12th. It will run every Tuesday and Thursday until 4:30pm throughout the school year. All K-8th grade students are eligible to attend after signing the permission form included in the family packet you will receive at our Open House August 17th or in the link below.
