Arrival/Dismissal - BE SAFE!

With slippery weather approaching, we wanted to remind you to follow the Arrival/Dismissal procedures. Please help keep the flow of traffic and keep our children safe:

- If you help your child out of the vehicle at morning drop-off, please park your car in the back. The fast drop off lane is for cars that take 30 seconds or less. We are experiencing backups.
- When there is a backup, please wait in line to drop off. We worry someone is going to get hit when passing on the left. The line will go faster when cars that take longer park in the back.
- For arrival and dismissal, we ask all cars enter from the East or church side and exit out the West or gym side. Do not drive against the flow of traffic. When slippery, this can be dangerous. Make sure to let Grandparents, Aunts, Uncles, or the person responsible for dropping off/picking up your child know our our school's drop off/pickup protocol.
