Reminders from our Staff!

 Please make sure your child knows how they are getting home from school. We are experiencing way too many 3rd-8th grade students wanting to call home throughout the day. This is a distraction to our classrooms and secretarial staff. We ask that the office phone be used for emergencies only. Thank you for your cooperation.

- Hot lunch orders must be received before 8:00 the day of hot lunch. We are having orders called in very late and/or have had between 10-15 students without a lunch each week in November. We do not order extras, so it is very difficult to give your child the hot lunch that the other kids are having if you do not pre-order. We do have cereal and other items available so that no child goes hungry.
- Students are asked to wear boots to school, change into school shoes (NO HEASLS), and have a pair of gym shoes with white, red, navy, or black socks. This will help tracking in salt and save our gym floor.
