

WE NEED PARENTS TO HELP at lunch and recess from 11:15-12:45 everyday. All volunteers that work with students 8 or less hours/month need to have a background check and complete an online virus training. If you are working with students more than 8 hours a month, you will also need to get fingerprinted.
