Currently we have a 13:1 student-teacher ratio school wide and we intend to keep it similar for the 2025-26 school year. Once a section is filled, students will be placed on a waiting list. We can not save spots for returning families past April 13th as enrollment opens up for parish families. Open enrollment for all families is April 23rd.

## **Optional P/T Conferences**& New Family Open House

Open registration for all students and our optional parent/teacher spring conferences will be held Wednesday, April 23, 2025 from 3:30-6:30 in the teacher's classrooms. Parents can visit anytime between 3:30-6:30. Doors will close promptly at 6:30, so make sure you come early enough to see your child's teacher. Because this is an optional event, there will be no scheduled times for parents.
