#### Dress Code Reminders/Summer Shopping

We want to give everyone a friendly reminder of our dress code prior to school shopping. Please remember we have an overflowing supply of cloths that are in great shape in our uniform closet that you can take whatever you need anytime during business hours of 8am-1pm in July. Below were our biggest issues for 2024-25.

- Shorts, skirts/jumpers at least 2 inches above the knee or longer.
- Socks must be white, navy, khaki, or black. NO Multicolored socks.
- Minimal jewelry. NO dangly earrings, hoop earrings, makeup, tattoos, or nail polish.
- No flip-flops, sandals, boots, clogs, or heals may be worn.
- Students should have an extra pair of gym shoes that are only to be worn to gym-NOT OUTSIDE. This will preserve our gym floor finishing with your help.
- Hair accessories should be small. Hair length for boys should be above the shirt collar & out of eyes. NO unnatural hair color (red, pink, etc) or hair bling.

#### Summer Homework!

You received an IXL username and password from your teacher to help with "summer slide" retention. If you need your IXL login information, please email your teacher and/or Mrs. Smith at ksmith@ollrcs.org. Studies show that students lose, on average, about 20 percent of their school-year gains in reading and 27 percent of their school-year gains in math during summer break. Below are some things you can work on over the summer:

#### Link to "Summer Slide Statistics and Prevention"

- Read for 15 minutes each day
- Flash cards of adding & subtracting for grades K-3 and multiplying for grades 3-8.

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- Practice tying shoes, zipping coats, and other daily skills that can be done independently, even by our youngest students!
- Correcting mispronounced words with your child. When students do not/can not pronounce words correctly, it is increasingly more difficult to spell words and write.
